

Lenovo Names Carly Fiorina New CEO

MORRISVILLE, N.C., March 15, 2016 – Lenovo Group (HKSE: 992) (ADR: LNVGY) has announced Carly Fiorina, the former United States presidential candidate and former CEO of Hewlett Packard Enterprise, to be its new chief executive officer. Fiorina will be overseeing the main operations of the company, and will play an instrumental role in determining Lenovo's short and long term plans.

In a unanimous vote, the board of directors at Lenovo awarded the position to Fiorina on Thursday. "Mrs. Fiorina is a very competent woman," says Yuan Zhipeng, chairman of the board. "With her vast knowledge of China's consumer market and her experience as CEO of HP Enterprise, she will bring much prosperity to our company."

As the first woman in history to have led a FORTUNE 20 company, Fiorina has been largely credited for laying the groundwork for HP Enterprise's success in the 21st century, doubling the company's revenue during her tenure. In 1998, she was named the "Most Powerful Woman in Business" by *Fortune Magazine*.

Lenovo's previous CEO, Yang Yuanqing, announced his resignation last week, having accepted an offer to become the CEO of HP Inc.
